Mrs. Edward Moogk of London, Ontario is offering for sale a collection of nearly 4,500 78 rpm. recordings. From the extensive collection of her late husband, Edward B. Moogk, these recordings are primarily popular in nature, boasting extensive holdings of such performances as Paul Whiteman and Jimmie Lunceford. Included also is a fine collection of band recordings (e.g., Arthur Pryor). Among the Canadian labels represented are Apex, Berliner, and Brunswick. Because of the nature of the collection, Mrs. Moogk is interested in selling it as a unit. It should also be noted that the National Library of Canada has recently published a paperback edition (in English) of Edward Moogk's Roll Back the Years (ISBN 0-660-01382-7; \$14.95 in Canada). The "grand old man" of Canadian recorded sound research and collecting, Ed is probably best known as the founder and first head of the National Library's Recorded Sound Collection.
