An alumna (BMus 1971) and distinguished independent researcher, Ruth spent many hours in the library researching and writing articles for the Encyclopedia of Music in Canada, Grove Music Online, and elsewhere. Interestingly, her mother Grace Pincoe was a music librarian and one of the first officers of the fledging Canadian Music Library Association (CMLA) in the early 1960s (the CMLA became the Canadian Association of Music Libraries in 1971). We are excited to announce the launch of the annual <u>Ruth Pincoe Research Fellowship</u>, a new award that supports original research and scholarship using materials from our archival and special collections.
